Professional services solicited by the Request for Qualifications generally include:

Determination of a location to construct the new West Laramie wastewater main lift station, determination of either removal or abandonment of the existing West Laramie wastewater main lift station, and design of the new West Laramie wastewater main lift station.

The City reserves the right to award this project to the firm who best addresses the requirements outlined in the Request for Qualifications.
