

ADVERTISEMENT TO BID

Notice is hereby given that the City of Laramie, Wyoming will receive electronic bids for the furnishing of all labor, materials, tools, appliances, transportation, and services necessary to complete the **B2 Sewer Line Replacement - Phase 2** project as called for in the Project Manual and generally described as follows:

This project has been designed with the intent to remove the existing, undersized sewer line between 17th and 11th Streets south of Spring Creek Drive and replace the line with 18" PVC or 20" HDPE pipe. The existing manholes will also be removed and replaced. This project will be done using a combination of open trench and pipe-bursting. All disturbed aspects including open field, gravel road, concrete, asphalt, and existing service lines will be required to be replaced and brought back to existing conditions.

Electronic bids shall be submitted online until 1:00 PM Local Time, on the 25th Day of April 2023, at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. All bids must be furnished electronically through the QuestCDN VirtuBid platform. Instructions for online bidding using QuestCDN have been attached as part of the Instructions to Bidders document. Bids which are not prepared and filed in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders may be rejected. The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids and the right to waive irregularities in bids received.

Each bid must be accompanied by a bid bond with sufficient surety, for not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount of such bid, payable to, and to be forfeited to, the City of Laramie as liquidated damages if bidder fails to enter into contract within thirty (30) days after award to him, or fails, at the time of executing the agreement, to furnish a performance bond and a payment bond each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the bid. Facsimile (fax) or other copies of bonds are not acceptable. **NO BID WILL BE CONSIDERED IF NOT ACCOMPANIED BY SUCH BOND, OR IF NOT IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF W.S. 15-1-113.**

A complete set of the Project Manual and Plans may be downloaded beginning the 25th day of March, 2023, via the City website <http://www.cityoflaramie.com/projects/>, which will lead to a QuestCDN website, where the bidder must login and pay a fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25). This login and deposit will ensure that the plan holders are identified and supplied the possible addendum and notices associated with the project.

A pre-bid conference shall be held at 10:30 AM on the 13th day of April 2023, at 4373 North 3rd Street, Laramie, WY 82072, at which attendance by Bidders is **not required**.
