

ADVERTISEMENT TO BID

Notice is hereby given that the City of Laramie, Wyoming will receive electronic bids for the furnishing of all labor, materials, tools, appliances, transportation, and services necessary to complete the **WWC6CI - C-LINE REPL PH 2 - 6TH ST - CANBY TO IVINSON** as called for in the Project Manual and generally described as follows:

Removal and replacement of existing vitrified clay pipe (VCP) sanitary sewer pipe with approximately 3,220 linear feet of new 24-inch polyvinyl chloride (PVC) sanitary sewer pipe, removal and replacement of approximately 300 linear feet of existing PVC and cast iron (CIP) water line with new 8-inch diameter AWWA C900 DR18 PVC water line, and miscellaneous modifications to the existing storm sewer system within North and South 6th Street and Canby Street. Construction will include removal and replacement of manholes, new PVC sanitary sewer pipe, connections to the existing sanitary sewer system, abandoning existing sanitary sewer at select locations, new service connections, removal and replacement of water line, new service connections, connections to the existing water line and all associated appurtenances, removal and replacement of select storm sewer inlets, manholes and associated storm sewer pipe, surface restoration, and all incidental work as shown on the construction drawings.

Electronic bids shall be submitted online until 1:00 PM Local Time, on the 9th day of May, 2023, at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. All bids must be furnished electronically through the QuestCDN VirtuBid platform. Instructions for online bidding using QuestCDN have been attached as part of the Instructions to Bidders document. Bids which are not prepared and filed in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders may be rejected. The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids and the right to waive irregularities in bids received.

Each bid must be accompanied by a bid bond with sufficient surety, for not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount of such bid, payable to, and to be forfeited to, the City of Laramie as liquidated damages if bidder fails to enter into contract within thirty (30) days after award to him, or fails, at the time of executing the agreement, to furnish a performance bond and a payment bond each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the bid. Facsimile (fax) or other copies of bonds are not acceptable, nor are certified cashier's checks, certified checks or bank drafts. **NO BID WILL BE CONSIDERED IF NOT ACCOMPANIED BY SUCH BOND, OR IF NOT IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF W.S. 15-1-113.**

A complete set of the Project Manual and Plans may be downloaded after the 1st day of April, 2023, via the City website <http://www.cityoflaramie.com/projects/>, which will lead to a QuestCDN website, where the bidder must login and pay a fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25). This login and deposit will ensure that the plan holders are identified and supplied the possible addendum and notices associated with the project.

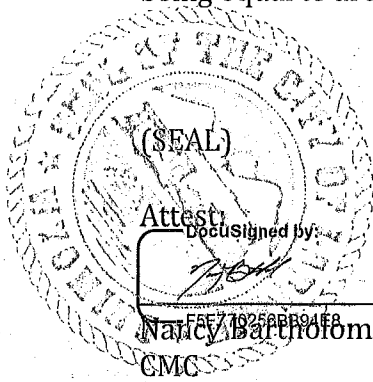
