



Code of Conduct for Car Show Special Event Permits

The City of Laramie is committed to promoting safe and enjoyable car show events for applicants, participants, and attendees.

The purpose of the Car Show Code of Conduct is to maintain a responsible and uniform car show event process for Special Event Applicants, and to ensure safety measures are in place to preserve the public health, safety, and welfare.

All provisions of this Code of Conduct must be followed unless otherwise approved. Exceptions will be determined on a case-by-case basis and must be requested in writing. If granted, a request for exception will be approved by the City Manager and kept on file.

Certain exceptions to Wyoming Statute can only be granted by the City Council. In those cases, approval will be obtained in a scheduled City Council meeting and a record of the proceedings will be kept on file.

When Conducting Your Car Show, You Will Need to:

- **Control Access to the Show Area.** Vehicles should enter and exit the showing area at specific times and at speed not exceeding 5 MPH to ensure safety for pedestrians, spectators, participants and to minimize the potential for property damage.
- **Publish & Enforce Rules.** Event sponsors should establish and publish rules for the car show to ensure participants know, *from the time they register to participate*, what conduct will be acceptable. Event sponsor(s) will need to designate an Event Official tasked with enforcing the event rules.

These standard and customary safety rules for car shows are recommended as a baseline minimum for keeping your event safe and in compliance with laws:

- ✓ No Burnouts, racing, donuts or displays of speed.
- ✓ No Excessive revving.
- ✓ Attendees and participants must always obey traffic laws while entering and exiting.
- ✓ No entry or exit from the vehicle showing area, except at designated times.
- ✓ Participants and attendees must follow directions of staff and the Event Official.
- ✓ Violation of event rules may result in disqualification and ejection from the event as determined by the Event Official.

Car show sponsors are encouraged to establish other rules as they determine necessary.
