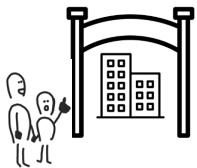
PROJECT OBJECTIVES

PLACEMAKING



Capitalize on our communities' authentic assets, stories, and history while enhancing its aesthetic appeal to make 3rd street feel warm and welcoming.

GATEWAYS



Provide gateway features at the north and south ends of the corridor to create a sense of arrival to Laramie's Downtown. Collaboration with the Laramie Public Art Coalition and the artist team will help develop a feature that emphasizes Laramie's history and culture.

COLLABORATION



Foster an open, transparent, and fun public process involving the downtown businesses, interested residents, designers, and City Staff.

ECONOMIC VITALITY



Enhance downtown commerce by encouraging drivers to stop, walk, and shop. Aesthetic improvements will encourage curiosity and exploration.

- This project intends to use public and stakeholder feedback to direct and influence design.

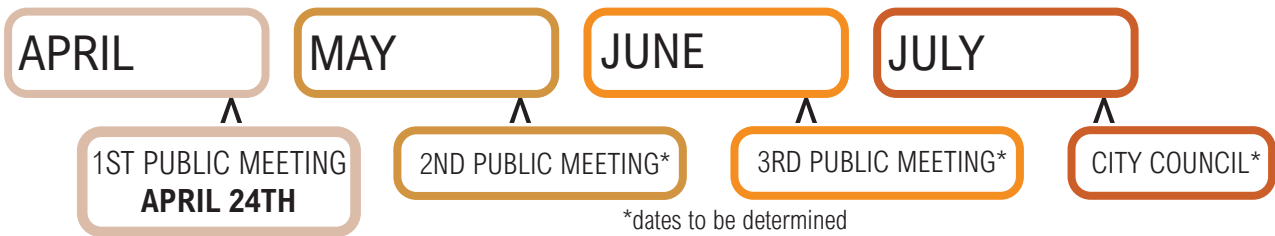
THIS PROJECT IS NOT:

PROCESS

- Step 1:** Research & Discovery
- Step 2:** Develop concepts using the feedback received from public participation
- Step 3:** Establish a preferred concept based on public feedback and governing body consideration
- Step 4:** Develop Construction Documents
- Step 5:** Build! (Pending funding availability)

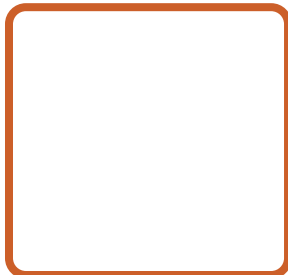
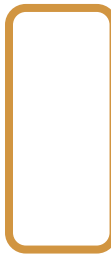
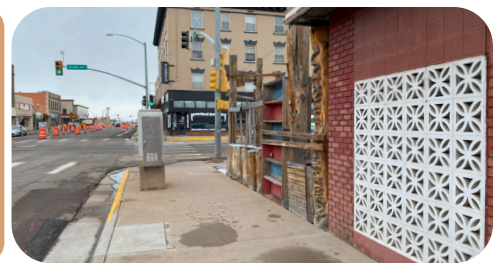
